All ALS Agency Administrators:

The 2019 New York State Collaborative document becomes effective January 1, 2020 but can be implemented sooner.

The Hudson Valley REMAC in conjunction with the Hudson Valley Protocol Committee are offering 2 options to complete the 2019 rollout of the collaborative ALS protocols. All ALS providers are required to complete one of these options by December 31, 2019. Any provider not completing the rollout material and/or not submitting the proper paperwork to their Primary Agency prior to December 31, 2019 will not be able to practice as an ALS provider in the Hudson Valley.

Each ALS Agency must ensure that all active providers that are associated with them (primary or other) have completed the ALS rollout and has submitted to the Regional office a copy of their certificate of completion (generated by the LMS System) or has forwarded a signed affidavit that they have completed the self-study option of the rollout. Once all active ALS providers have completed the rollout, the agency should notify the Regional office of the Agency's implementation date of the 2019 ALS Collaborative Protocols.
